If your career or interests lie in the exciting world of fashion, beauty and makeup artistry, give yourself the best start you can with the Kristen Stewart School of Makeup.

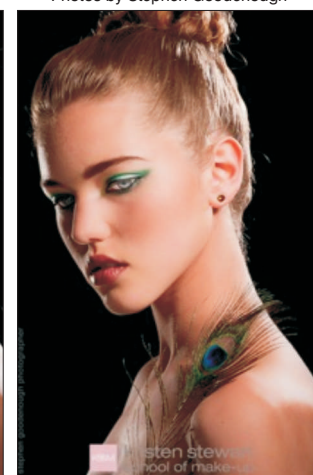

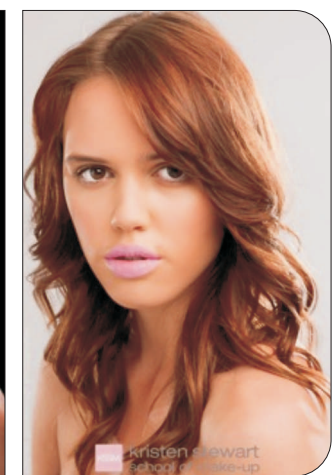
